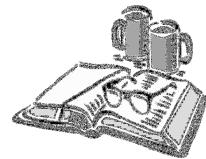
Volunteers Still Needed

You Are Invited to an Informational Dinner about Sunset International Bible Institute

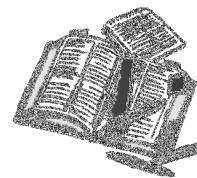
