It's official! Footsteps will now offer 3 fun filled school days starting in September, 2010!! Over the years, many of our families have expressed a great interest for Footsteps to offer more days of instruction. Recent changes have made it possible for Footsteps to obtain a comprehensive and full license from the State of Texas. Hence, allowing us to provide additional days of fun and learning.

Monday will be our third school day!! You now have two great options to choose from:

- Tuesday & Thursday
- Monday, Tuesday & Thursday

Once you have chosen the schedule that best fits your child, and your lifestyle,

that is the schedule you will be registered for. Hence, if you are registered for two days a week, the only two days your child will be able to attend are Tuesday and Thursday. Likewise, if you register for three days a week, you will be financial obligated to that schedule through the semester's end. The fall semester ends in December, 2010 and the spring semester ends in May, 2011.

There is also a new fee schedule. Tuition for a Tuesday/Thursday schedule is now \$250/month. And tuition for all three days will be \$325/month. The registration and supply fee has not changed.

These changes are necessary to compensate for the additional fees associ-

ated with licensing and to maintain our professional teaching staff.

Please notify me, via e-mail, if you will be attending Footsteps 2 days (Tuesday & Thursday) or 3 days (Monday, Tuesday and Thursday).
